General Questions

When is the best season to travel in Canada?

In our eyes, it's always a pleasure to travel to Canada. From April to May, snow is visible, and lakes are still frozen from winter. Bears emerge from hibernation, and national parks are busy with wildlife. Summer is from June to August, and it's the most popular season for outdoor activities and wildlife viewing. In autumn, from September to November, temperatures cool and the leaves change. In winter, from December to early March, the landscape transforms into a breathtaking wonderland.

Will I see wildlife?

Most of our tours take place between April and September, when wildlife is at its most abundant and active. All our holidays visit national parks for the best chance to see wildlife, including bears, wolves and bald eagles.

On a cruise through Alaska's Inside Passage, it's likely you will see marine and land mammals from aboard your ship. For a closer look, however, we recommend you book shore excursions that include visits to wilderness parks.

Will I have Wi-Fi access?

Free Wi-Fi is available on coaches in Canada and the USA. As coaches use a satellite system, routing may cause restricted reception. Wi-Fi is also available in most hotels and all Fairmont properties, and is available for purchase on Holland America Line cruises. Wi-Fi is not available on coaches in Alaska.

What time is hotel check-in and check-out?

Hotel check-in is usually at 4pm. Where possible, the hotel will try to have your room ready earlier. To guarantee early check-in, you will need to book an additional night prior to your scheduled arrival (additional expense). Hotel check-out is at 11am or noon.

What clothing should I pack?

Pack a variety of clothing to suit the time of year in which you're travelling. Most guests dress casually during the day, but we recommend that you pack an array of comfortable light to medium weight clothes, plus rainwear. If you are travelling in winter, you will need to bring clothes that can be layered, and a waterproof outer layer, as temperatures can drop to lows of between -15 and -40 degrees Celsius. Ensure you have appropriate footwear.

Rocky Mountaineer

How long is my Rocky Mountaineer rail journey?

You will spend two days on board Rocky Mountaineer, travelling around 450 kilometres each day in Canada, all in daylight.

Which route will I be travelling?

'First Passage to the West' journeys operate both east and westbound between Vancouver and Lake Louise or Banff. You'll travel through the Canadian Rocky Mountains, past Kicking Horse River, through the Spiral Tunnels and over the Continental Divide along the Canadian Pacific track.

Journey Through the Clouds' takes you between Vancouver and Jasper, past some of the tallest peaks in the Canadian Rockies, including Mount Robson. You'll travel through remote countryside alongside the Coast Mountains, Fraser Canyon, Albreda Glacier and Pyramid Falls.

Please check individual itineraries for the direction of travel.

What is the baggage size allowance on board?

Only hand luggage is permitted on the Rocky Mountaineer and you will not have access to checked luggage while on board the train. Your checked luggage will be delivered to your overnight accommodation in Kamloops. Please ensure everything you'll need during the rail journey is packed in your hand luggage, and everything you can do without is securely stowed away.

VIA Rail

How long is my VIA Rail journey?

The overnight journey from Vancouver to Jasper takes approximately 18.5 hours.

What are the cabin facilities on VIA Rail?

Your VIA Rail journey will be in Sleeper Plus class. By night, your private twin cabin features an upper and lower bed. By day, the cabin features two seats facing each other. A private washroom is available inside each cabin and guests have access to a shared shower room. For single cabins, enquire for further details.

What is the baggage size allowance on board?

If your holiday includes a rail journey on VIA Rail, you will be required to pack down to an overnight bag (max 11kg). You will not have access to checked luggage during your rail journey.



Airfares

Air travel is arranged with independent airlines. APT will arrange air travel as advertised in connection with your holiday package or otherwise arranged with APT. All airfares are subject to flight and booking class availability. Airfares will be booked and ticketed upon receipt of your deposit to avoid price or tax increases. Airport taxes vary for each departure point and routing of airline. Airline schedules are subject to change without notice. Once air tickets are issued, airline amendment and/or cancellation fees apply and, in some cases, are non-refundable. Name changes and voluntary date and schedule changes will incur fees. APT is not liable for delays or disruptions of air travel. Once tickets are issued APT will have no other liability and will not be responsible for refunding the cost of any services booked in conjunction with the flights. services booked in conjunction with the flights.

Airline Loyalty Points Eligibility

APT uses the services of a range of airlines in its packages. APT does not warrant that its airlfares attract loyalty points as airlines control the application of loyalty points in all cases. Requests to use loyalty points to upgrade travel need to be directed to the airline concerned by the member.

APT Deposit Cancellation Peace of Mind

APT Deposit Cancellation Peace of Mind
Applicable when an upfront fee of \$95 per person is paid with your deposit. The holiday package can be cancelled prior to the final payment date and your deposit will be retained as an APT holding credit to be used for future bookings. Twin/Triple Room prices are subject to availability and based on existing room/cabin sizes, hotel bedding (twin/double beds) or stateroom availability on cruises (normally max. two beds per room). While cruising, triple cabins will consist of a sofa bed.

Solo Travellers

A limited number of single rooms/suites/cabins may be available by request at time of booking your cruise/holiday package. Single room/suites/cabins are not available on certain cruises. Single rooms/suites/cabins are usually smaller than standard twin or double rooms and often only have one single bed.


