Some journeys take you far from home; others carry you to the very edge of the map. The Arctic Norway Frontier – Oslo, Fjords & Svalbard belongs firmly in the latter category. Travelling from Oslo to Longyearbyen, it follows a route that combines rail and sea travel with small-ship exploration, culminating in the rare chance to sail across 80° North beneath the glow of the Midnight Sun.

The adventure begins in Oslo, where modern Nordic culture meets old-world charm, before boarding the Flåm Railway. This iconic line threads through deep valleys and along waterfalls, a dramatic prelude to the landscapes still to come. The journey continues to Bergen, where the sea becomes your highway north.

The coastal voyage reveals Norway at its most elemental: the jagged silhouettes of the Lofoten Islands, the Arctic city of Tromsø, and the cliffs of the North Cape, Europe's northernmost point. Each day brings another stretch of wild shoreline, with fishing villages tucked between fjords and mountains.

Beyond the mainland lies Svalbard, an Arctic archipelago suspended between Norway and the North Pole. Longyearbyen, the world's northernmost town, marks the gateway to this next chapter. From here, a small expedition ship pushes deeper into the High Arctic. The itinerary includes Ny-Ålesund, a settlement with a long history of polar science, and remote fjords where glaciers calve into icy seas. Sailing across the 80th parallel, you enter the realm of polar bears, walrus, and seabirds, all under a sun that never sets.

One of the most memorable experiences is a silent cruise aboard a hybridelectric catamaran. Gliding quietly through waters studded with ice, you come face to face with glaciers in a way that feels both intimate and respectful of the fragile environment.

This is more than a holiday. It is a passage through landscapes that few ever see, stitched together by train, coastal steamer, and expedition ship. The result is a rare journey that captures the essence of Norway and the Arctic frontier—wild, remote, and unforgettable.




















DAY 4


