

morning tea. Explore a historic homestead that has been a part of the Longreach social history for over 100 years. Back in town, visit the world-class Qantas Founders Museum that tells the story of how the airline was founded. View marvellous interpretive and interactive exhibits and join a guided Airpark tour before lunch. Late afternoon, visit Camden Park Station. Join Outback Dan on a personalised tour of his family property, sunset drinks at Two Tree Hill, followed by an exclusive dinner in their 100-year-old woolshed. (B,L,D)

Today marvel at the ever-changing landscapes as you travel from Longreach to Winton. Enjoy a tour of the town to discover the quirky Arno's Wall and play a tune on what is believed to be the world's only musical fence. Learn the story behind Australia's unofficial national anthem at the Waltzing Matilda Centre; the only museum dedicated to a song. Next visit the Australian Age of Dinosaurs. Join a guided interpretive tour of the laboratory, collection room and Dinosaur Canyon. This evening is a very special sunset barbecue dinner overlooking the plains where dinosaurs once roamed!
